How it works

You can enter the lottery for as little as £5 per month. Upon receipt of your initial payment, you will be issued with your unique lottery number.

You can purchase as many entries as you wish.

The draw will take place on the first working day of each month with prizes being remitted directly to the winners. There is no need to claim.

You must be aged 16 or over to enter.

Prizes

The charity's aim is to distribute three monthly cash prizes of £500, £200 and £100, to a maximum value of £800.

The prize distribution will be possible when there are at least 400 lottery members. If there are fewer members, the prize allocation will comprise 40% of the monthly proceeds distributed in a similar ratio to that shown above.
